## **ICCC Pastor Retreat Program**

In 2020, we received a Duke Divinity Leadership Education Program grant that provides funding to support five regional pastor retreats this year.

The purpose for this retreat is:

- To provide a time for personal and spiritual renewal
- To provide a time for mutual support and learning
- To strengthen relationships between ICCC member pastors and potential ICCC pastors. Most of the retreat participants shall be ICCC member pastors.

The grant provides the following funding:

- Lodging and food for up to two (2) nights for ten (10) pastors using a retreat facility = \$3,000 (\$300/person). A minimum of 6 participating pastors is required for the retreat.
- A speaker/facilitator for the retreat at \$300/day for two (2) days = \$600
- A person to organize the retreat at \$250
- Pastors are responsible for their transportation costs

To apply for this retreat funding, a one-page application is to be submitted to Rev. Phil Tom at <a href="iccept@sbcglobal.net">iccept@sbcglobal.net</a>. The funds must be administered by a designated ICCC member congregation. The congregation's treasurer will provide a detailed financial report with documented receipts of all expenses for the retreat. ICCC is responsible to account for the use of these grant funds to the Duke Divinity Leadership Education Program. The retreat must be completed before December 31, 2020.
