

## International Council of Community Churches 2022 Mission Grant Qualifications

The International Council of Community Churches is offering **Mission Grants** to their local churches to assist their ministry and mission in their local communities.

- A. Qualifications for these 2022 Mission Grants are:
  - 1. The church must be a current 2022 member of the ICCC.
  - 2. The church must be engaged in a local mission project (alone or jointly with another church) that benefits and serves people in your local community.
  - 3. Mission grant money must be used directly to benefit people in your community and not used for administrative purposes.
- B. Examples of qualifying mission programs are (but not limited to): food pantry or meal program, after-school learning or recreation program, reading, tutoring or mentorship program, senior citizen meal or activity program, quilt/blanket ministry, local resettlement of a refuge or migrant family, racism or racial justice education program.
- C. Applications may be submitted to the ICCC between June 1 and November 30, 2022. The application must be mailed or emailed to the International Council of Community Churches, P.O. Box 846, Longmont, CO 80502. Email: <a href="mailto:iccnow@sbcglobal.net">iccnow@sbcglobal.net</a> Applications must be received by the ICCC by the November 30, 2022 deadline.
- D. Mission grants will be \$ 500 or less. Application approval and final determination of grant amount will be by the ICCC Informational Services and Outreach Committee.
- E. Recipients of mission grants will be notified in early December, 2022, and will be asked to share information and pictures with the ICCC and be invited to attend the 2023 ICCC Annual Conference in Charlotte, NC, next July, 2023
